

Dear Snowline Owners:

Please note that the redlined bylaws sent with the voting packet was a non-final draft of proposed bylaw amendments. The final version has been posted online in the Member section of the Snowline website for viewing. There are several formatting changes in the final version and one substantive difference which is shown here in redline:

5.1.1 Number of Directors. The number of Directors on the Board shall ~~initially~~ be at ~~least five (5) but not more than nine (9)~~ seven (7) persons elected by the Members of the Association. Newly elected Board members shall take office upon adjournment of the meeting at which they were elected. Promptly following such election, the Board shall elect or appoint the Officers of the Association described in Article 6 hereof.

The letter dated August 23 (included in the voting packet) from Snowlines attorney, Jeremy Stilwell, addresses this change as follows:

Section 5.1.1 Number of Directors. The current Bylaws call for not less than 5 nor more than 9 directors. We prefer that associations have a set number of directors; in this instance, we have selected 7. The Association can still expand or contract the size of the Board, but it would require a vote to amend the bylaws. Having a set number clearly complies with Washington law and avoids issues that arise when current board members have authority to expand or contract the number of directors.
